

**You are ready for the Knowledge Test....
Now What?**

Step 1

Gather all necessary paperwork.

When you go to take your test, you will need to show a current picture ID, with signature, along with proof of eligibility.

Your proof of eligibility comes from an endorsement from your instructor, certificate of graduation or a statement issued from an authorized agency.

Step 2

***Decide when/where you are going to
take your test.***

The FAA requires all FAA knowledge exams be taken at an FAA designated LaserGrade or CATS testing facility.

Coyote Flight Centers is a LaserGrade testing facility designated to administer FAA knowledge exams.

Step 3

Call and schedule your testing appointment.

We suggest calling 24 hours in advance to schedule your test. At this time, Coyote Flight Centers only accepts cash, checks or money orders. If you wish to pay by credit card you can do so by contacting LaserGrade Central Office (1-800-211-2753) to schedule your test.

Tests are scheduled during normal operating hours. If you are not able to test during these hours, please contact the office. We will do what we can to work with your schedule. Please note that LaserGrade is not able to schedule a test outside office hours without a testing center's approval.

FAQ

1. How much does the test cost?

All FAA exams are currently \$90 for each exam.

2. Will I get my score the same day I take the test?

Yes. You will receive a test report when you complete the test. The testing center will place a seal on your report to make it official.

3. Will I know what I missed?

Your test report will list subject codes for any question you missed. You will not know the exact question, only the subject area.

4. What if I don't pass the test?

You will need to have an authorized instructor endorse your test report after you have demonstrated you are ready to test again.

5. Can I retest for a higher score?

Yes, within 30 days of the original test. The latest test will be the official score, even if you didn't do as well. The original test report will need to be presented to the testing center.

6. How long is the test good for?

Your test score is good for 24 calendar months.

7. What if I loose my report?

You will need to contact the FAA for a duplicate report.
